Who can Apply?

* Students must find a mentor within the Biochemistry Department faculty (students with ongoing research projects in BCH labs do qualify).

Application Instructions:

- Submit an Application document including:
 - Your Major, overall GPA, relevant classwork
 - A statement of research goals.
 - Performance in the BCH 301/302 BCH 222 courses is taken into account.
- Identify the Biochemistry Dept primary faculty member that you have spoken to about doing summer research, or in whose lab you are currently.
